5 mins: Imagine you're entering a spaceship when you enter this classroom each day 5 mins: Name Game

- Say together, with clapping: "Cherice...Cherice would bring a chef," and repeat around the circle for each person

12 mins: Activity

- Explain Field Journals

- Share
- If we were going to construct a spaceship, what would it need? Write down at least 5 things in your field journal.
- Share
- What else might we need, if we had to live on that spaceship for the foreseeable future?

• From this view, we ARE on a spaceship, the only tiny life support system that we know of in the entire universe, and the only one that we can access at this point

10 mins: Book, *You're Aboard Spaceship Earth* (offer for them to color if they want) 5 mins: discussion about book, jobs

- If we were on a spaceship, what jobs would we need people to do?
- What job would you want to do on a spaceship?
- Connect this to the fact that we can all do jobs on our spaceship to help take care of it

5 mins: overview of the week, connect with idea of peace, and sign up for jobs
